2018 Chardonnay - Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

Feel the winds come sweeping down the plains as you enjoy a Category 5 vintage that is sure to be memorable. Nothing goes better with a Golden Hurricane than friends, fans, and a good time. So, raise your hurricane flag, as we celebrate 100 years of one of the most unique nicknames in the country. This is a storm you won't want to miss.

Hailing from the cool and foggy climate for the Russian River Valley in Sonoma County, this beautiful medium bodied wine was grown slowly to build intense flavors over time. This wine was aged in French oak and displays a beautiful balance of fruit, oak and liveliness on the palate and exhibits lush mango and toasted almond. Balanced fruit with tarte acidity makes this wine a classic example of Premium Russian River Chardonnay.

This premium sparkling wine – meticulously and artfully made in the traditional champagne method – rivals anything found from the best Champagne houses in Épernay and Reims. Blended superbly from 100% Chardonnay, this magnificent Napa Valley Blanc de Blancs exhibits beautiful green apple and tropical notes in the aroma follows through in the mouth with a smooth fine mousse. This wine finishes with refreshing, lingering light tropical flavors that beg for another sip.

2018 Red Blend - Napa Valley

When you're living on Tulsa Time it is easy to relax and enjoy a city steeped in a rich history of music and the arts. The words of Woody Guthrie, Leon Russell, and Bob Dylan define a unique sound. Landmarks such as the famous Cain's Ballroom evoke the nostalgia of times gone by. So, "set your watch back to it" and enjoy Living on Tulsa Time.

This proprietary red blend – from our award-winning winemaker Todd Heth – exhibits dark blackberry, bing cherry, and plum notes perfectly into layers of coffee and tobacco. The finish is dry with long-lasting berry fruit. Silky but firm tannins, this wine is enjoyable now but has the ability to age well in the cellar.

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Special Collections

2020 Pinot Noir - Santa Barbara County

McFarlin Library, the heart of The University of Tulsa campus, houses a rich array of nearly 1,000 collections of over 12 million archives and over 160,000 rare books, collectively known as Special Collections. The earliest collection began with a gift from Alice Mary Robertson in the late 1920s of Native American artifacts, and now includes one of the largest collections of James Joyce.

Our Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir benefits from a cool, extended growing season akin to Burgundy, France, but with a unique twist of dense Pacific fog. This fog provides optimal moisture for our Pinot Noir, creating an ideal growing condition without overstay. The wine features aromas of cherries, raspberries, blackberries, and brown sugar, complemented by baking spices. On tasting, it unveils bright strawberry flavors, leading to a rounded mouthfeel and soft, velvety tannins, culminating in a long, elegant finish.

100 Year Storm

2020 Cuvée Blanc - Napa Valley

Celebrating 100 years of the “Golden Hurricane” nickname, we honor our history. In 1922, Coach Howard Acher aimed to highlight his team's potential with a unique identity. Initially inspired by the team's powerful performance likened to a tornado, Acher considered “Golden Tomatoes” but found it taken. Before a game against Texas A&M, Acher proposed “Golden Hurricane” to reflect their new gold jerseys. The team agreed, and Tulsa triumphed in their first game with this name, 13-10.

This white wine blend is alluring and complex, presenting tropical fruits, white flowers, and subtle spice. The nose bursts with ripe lemon, white peach, and orange blossom, enhanced by toast and white pepper notes. On the palate, lemon leads, accompanied by pineapple and tropical fruit, underpinned by vanilla. The finish is bright and zingy, softening into vanilla and subtle spices.

Tulsa Sound

2019 Cabernet Sauvignon - Napa Valley

The legendary “Tulsa Sound” is a signature style of country, blues, rock, and soul blended together to create a shuffle groove. Founded by Leon Russell and JJ Cale it was further brought to life in the historic Church Studio in the 1970s. The unique melodies and lyrics of the genre inspired a camaraderie that continues to inspire and bring together a new generation of musicians and TU fans.

Our flagship Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a classic representation of the appellation's preeminent varietal. Notes of black cherry, blackberry and plum are complemented by hits of toasted oak, dried currant and baking spice. Fine-grained tannins and ample brightness on the palate give way to a polished mouthfeel and exceptionally long finish.
